

Proposal to change the title of the Vice President Academic Affairs

The Union Notes:

- The term 'Vice President Academic Affairs' has been a Student Leader title for the past five (5) years.
- The title was created at a time when the Students' Union had less independency from the University than it now does, and the title fits in with the University Committee Structure.
- Most Students' Unions have the title Vice President Education/Education Officer

The Union Believes:

- The term 'Academic Affairs' no longer needs to fit with the University
 Committee structure, as there is increased independency from the University
- The term 'Academic Affairs' does not make it clear to students what the role of the Vice President is.
- The title 'Vice President Education' makes it clear that the role of the Vice President is to make change surrounding anything to do with a students' education.
- The title 'Vice President Education' is more relevant to our students

The Union Resolves:

• To change the title of the 'Vice President Academic Affairs' to the 'Vice President Education'
