<b>Report Summary</b>	My focus over the last month has been welcoming students back to campus first and foremost and getting feedback from students regarding accommodation concerns and coming up with ideas on how to progress the Campaigns Network.

KPI 1 - Create an Eco-Award with a target participation of 150 students by July 2021	<b>Progress this month:</b>	The Eco-award is still being embedded into the Feel-Good Programme and is set to launch in November.
	<b>Plans for next month:</b>	During November I plan to use the comms I have written to publicise the Award to students through all sabbatical channels and sign them up.
KPI 2 - In the membership insight package 70% of students will agree that the SU provides tools for students to live more sustainably	<b>Progress this month:</b>	Vlog 2 about plastic and where to buy plastic-free items in Lincoln was released and well received by students. I have completed a rough draft for the Enviro-Fayre 2021 (both a normal plan and a Covid-safe plan). I have also decided to incorporate the plastic-free market idea into the Enviro-fayre to assess how much demand there is.
	<b>Plans for next month:</b>	Release the 3 <sup>rd</sup> vlog about Recycling.
KPI 3 – In the membership insight package, 60% of students will believe that the Campaigns Network represents the needs of the student body	<b>Progress this month:</b>	I put forward to the Environment and Sustainability Committee that I provide an update on the Environmental report to the committee to ask for help as well as share wins. I came up with some ideas for a group campaign for the Campaigns Network which I am yet to run through with the Campaigns Groups so will update next month. Officers also attended their 2 Campaigns Fayres and were able to speak to interested students.
	<b>Plans for next month:</b>	To make the campaigns network membership last the entire time which students are at the University as I think they are losing out on interested members as the membership doesn't automatically role over for people who signed up. Run through ideas for the CN at the next CN meeting and get their feedback.



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KPI 4 – Increase student-friendly outdoor space on-campus by 10% (square footage)	Progress this month:	Students have been enjoying the new seating outside and I am putting out comms to students explaining all the eco-friendly additions to our venues. I had a great meeting with Libby John (Head of College of Science) who is keen to work with myself on converting the Secret Garden to a student friendly green space on-campus. I am awaiting costings on this from Estates who are helping me with the process.
	Plans for next month:	Continue discussions with estates regarding more outdoor spaces and the potential of getting students to Riseholme.
KPI 5 – All 3rd party accommodation providers will have recycling facilities by July 2021	Progress this month:	Initial comms were sent to all 3 <sup>rd</sup> party accommodation providers with little response (only those who provide recycling already responded). I have been in contact with the Council regarding the barriers which might be in place to getting recycling at accommodations and they have been really helpful.
	Plans for next month:	Continue to contact accommodations and dig for answers.
KPI 6 – 85% of the Campaigns Network members will be satisfied with the Campaigns Network	Progress this month:	I have written some ideas of what I would like to ask CN members at the mid-year review in December. I have also come up with some ideas on how to publicise the network better which I am yet to speak to the CN about so will update next month.
	Plans for next month:	Keep up the Committee Member of the Month award. Also, just generally supporting Volunteer Officers. Ask the CN for feedback regarding my publicity ideas.
