

Santander Student Funding Available 2016 – 2017

As a current student at the University of Lincoln you can gain funding through the University Santander funding partnership to support work experience opportunities.

If you are currently working for a company/organisation on an unpaid basis or if you are interested in working for them you can explore this funding, with the support of the Careers team.

Funding is available from £300 up to £1,500 and a company/organisation can access this funding to support you in a role with them.

There are certain checks that the Careers & Employability team will have to do, but we would be happy for you to approach companies/organisations with this sheet and the proposal to outline the scheme to them and we always welcome ideas from you.

What can you do now?

A couple of things you can check with the company/organisation:

- Are they a Small to Medium Sized Enterprise (SME)?
- Would they be happy to recruit you on a full time (35 hours per week) basis for at least 1 week or part time equivalent?
- Would they be willing to complete an agreement form to access some funding for you?
- Ask if the company are happy for you to pass on your details to the Careers team.
