<p>To support the CEO to write and have in place by June 2020 the new University Of Lincoln Student Union Strategy 2020-2024</p>	<p>Progress this month: Since my last report at the end of February, I have continued to gather student feedback on research and ideas for the new strategy. This was done by creating an officer Strategy workshop. This workshop was very successful with our volunteer officers and reps feeding in ideas, representing their demographics on what they thought should be included with a report created from the session. This month I have also visited Atlanta where I was to attend the ACUI conference for the strategy, however sadly due to the COVID-19 virus, this conference was postponed with myself, CEO and Deputy CEO hurrying to get back to the UK before the borders closed.</p> <p>Plans for next month: The plans for next month is to gather more feedback for the Strategy on what students see as their 'Student Experience', looking at other ways in which we can generate student feedback online.</p>
<p>To lead and support on 3 campus wide campaigns with 60% of students being aware of all 3 campaigns as measured in the new 'Member Insight Package'</p>	<p>Progress this month: This month I have led on our third and final campus wide campaign, 'Green Week'. This was very successful with students getting involved from different groups, including students who don't usually get involved from in the Students Union. We gave away over 500 toothbrushes and water bottles and 200 Lincoln sourced, vegan brownies. Also giving away a Nutribullet and getting involved in a non-waste promotion. A panel was also held however sadly this was not as well attended as wanted.</p> <p>Plans for next month: Plans for next month is to have a look at our previous campaigns to analyse what worked and didn't, also to do a final campaign on exam stress and escapism what was asked by students. This will have to be dependent on the circumstances of the Covid-19 to see if we are able to successfully do this online.</p>

<p>To continue to work and lead on facilitating student discussions regarding the disaffiliation of the SU from NUS, as agreed by the ULSU Board of Trustees</p>	<p>Progress this month:</p> <p>Plans for next month:</p>	<p>After an extremely successful NUS town hall meeting, we have gathered all the data and are now processing it to put into plans for next year. However, due to the financial state of the Student Union due to the Covid-19 circumstances, this will have to be looked into. We are in unknown times now with financials as we are losing around £120,000 a week due to closing down our venues.</p> <p>However, this will not be looked over, this will be looked into by my next year's team on what to do with the saving of NUS however as mentioned, this will be determined by the financial state of the SU after the coronavirus pandemic.</p> <p>Overall, this KPI has been completed with initial talks, then the ASM, then the referendum, then the official leaving of NUS with plans in place for next year.</p>
