What has been worked on in the past month?

This past month I've been working on collecting TEF feedback and ensuring that the first few assignment deadlines have been conducted appropriately. I've been involved in a Learning & Teaching committee to discuss next year's curriculum revalidation. Discussions on how we as a school can continue to garner an academic community from Level 1 onwards have been held and this has resulted in more opportunities for academic societies to speak during timetabled sessions.
