#### What has been worked on in the past month:

- Collaboration event with RAG – date, event type, place, times, charities, entertainment, cost, etc.
- Transgender Day of Remembrance (20<sup>th</sup> November) – room bookings, external and internal speakers, SingIt Society, memorial details.
- Regular weekly meeting topics and engagement.
- Two-weekly social events.
- Further campaign ideas with our new Campaigns Officer.
- Engaging people to be a part of the survey for the Gender-Based taskforce team meeting.

#### Successes from the past month:

- Getting further to having the details completely organised for the RAG Collaboration – venue, entertainment, date, time and charities have been established.
- TDoR – SingIt Society has officially agreed to be a part of it, a venue has been booked and we have two external interested speakers, with students also wanting to get on board.
- Weekly meetings – they are being received well, with more and more students coming each week (averaging 30 per week).
- Social events have been well received and engaging.
- I have had 30 people respond to the survey so far.

- Complete TDoR and hope that everyone enjoys it and learns the significance of the event if they are not already aware.
- Writing up the report for the Gender-based Violence Taskforce, and hoping it brings the evidence needed to make a change.
