### Visibility and Impact

With the majority of students now away from campus, it has been a quiet time for the officers. As stated in previous reports, the majority focus has been on building the new sabbatical team and ensuring that we are ready for the new academic year.

I have been in the process of planning events for Black History Month. As part of ensuring that we are looking at underrepresented groups and advocating for those groups, the VPWC and I are looking to ensure that the Campaigns Network are strong and empowered so we have been looking at priority campaigns that need to run to raise the profile of wider issues.

The VPE and I have also been working in partnership with the university on a new Inclusive Curriculum project that will look to address the issues around accessibility and attainment in students at Lincoln. We are in the process of compiling information from Kingston Union and their Curriculum Consultants framework. This work is ongoing.

We have also had the opportunity to liaise with the new DVC Student Development and Engagement and highlight areas that we are working on this year, and where plans can align. Thus far the relationship is positive and progressing.

Similarly to events last year, we engaged with prospective students on social media welcoming them to the university and putting forward who the Student Leaders were. It was a worthwhile exercise which gained a lot of reach and acknowledgement from current and new students. This year we incorporated an added element of a Q&A type session through Instagram, which was well received. We are hoping to capitalise on this further when the new academic year begins.
